EVENT INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES:

Briggs Charity Race \$50 per driver, TAG Pro Race \$100 per driver, all other classes: \$80 pre-entry, \$90 at track. Pit pass not included with entry. (Temporary Membership available at \$20 per driver for the weekend.)

PIT PASSES:

\$30 Event pass sold Thur & Fri, \$25 2-day Event Pass sold Sat. \$15 1-day passes available Fri - Sun. Children 7 & under: \$15 Event pass, \$10 daily pass. Do not purchase pit passes in advance. RA Minor Waiver signed by parent or legal guardian is required for all drivers under age 18.

PRACTICE:

Friday, July 10, \$65 per driver with pre-entry, \$90 at track. You must be entered in a class to practice.

CAMPING:

Camping is allowed throughout the RA facility and is available via permit Thursday - Saturday nights. Camping is not allowed outside the track. Fees are as follows: \$50 motorhomes, \$35 tents, \$20 Electrical hookups tags. All may be purchased at the RA Administrative Office upon arrival. Reserved camping areas (with electrical hookups, no water) are available and can also be purchased once at the facility at the RA office. The RA Office closes at 5pm on 7/9 & is open 7am-5pm 7/10 & 7/11. Late arrivals on 7/9 may camp overnight however must report to the RA office Friday morning to purchase permits. Tents are not allowed in the paved/reserved camping areas. Showers and on-site dump stations available. Area campgrounds: Hoeff's Resort & Campground Cascade 262.626.2221; Plymouth Rock Camping Resort Plymouth 920.893.8452; Three Guys and a Grill at Marsh Lodge Elkhart Lake 920.876.2535.

REFUNDS:

No refunds after Tuesday, July 7, 2009 at 5pm.

MISCELLANEOUS:

No engines can be run before 8:30am or after 5pm on Friday and before 8am or after 6pm on Saturday & Sunday. All pre-entered competitors must personally pick up their pre-entry packet at registration and must also have

personally executed their waiver signature when purchasing their pit pass. Facility must be vacated by 8pm Sunday. Late departure from the premises is by prior arrangement only - however, is not allowed in the paddock area. Violators are subject to a \$1,000 fee for release of unit.

PIT VEHICLES:

No bikes, skateboards, golf carts, 3 or 4 wheelers or any other form of unauthorized vehicles allowed in the pits during hot track hours. Handicap vehicles allowed via permit by WKA. ALL unlicensed vehicles (golf carts, scooters, mopeds, small 4-wheelers, etc.) must obtain a Road America Pit Vehicle Permit. Any motorized pit vehicle licensed to be on the road does not need this pass. Please complete the Pit Vehicle Permit located on the following pages. Rental golf carts are available through RA; contact Lori Bramstedt at 800.365.7223.

VENDOR NOTICE:

Any Non-Sponsor Vendors wishing to sell or display at a WKA National event must contact the WKA Office 30 days prior to the event for a WKA Vendors License @ 704.455.1606. WKA reserves the right to limit non-sponsor vendors.

TRACK LOCATION & DIRECTIONS:

Physical address: N7390 Hwy 67, Elkhart Lake, WI 53020
Directions: Take I-43 North from Milwaukee to Hwy 57 junction at Saukville. Go North on Hwy 57 to County J. Turn left (West) on County J. Go 2 miles to Hwy 67 and turn right (North). Proceed to Gate 6 (Competitor Gate) approximately 1 mile on your left.

SHIPPING INFORMATION:

There will be a per package charge for shipments sent to RA for participants. A \$5 handling fee will be charged per package sent to RA. There will be a minimum charge of \$50 for all shipments that need to be unloaded by RA personnel, using RA equipment. Sunoco 110 Leaded Race Fuel will be available for purchase at the event. Sunoco gas pump is credit card operated & open 24 hours. All National 2-Cycle Sprint Classes except CIK & WKA 125 Sprint Shifters must run the following spec fuel & oil mixtures. Mix 8 ounces of any of the following oils to 1 gallon of race gas sold at the track (pump will be designated): Blendzall 455 Ultra, Blendzall 460 Castor, Blendzall 4600 Green, Burris Blend, Burris Castor, Manhattan Oil Power Plus 2 Stroke Oil, Motul 800 2T (off-road), Redline 2 cycle Kart Oil, Redline 2 Stroke Racing Oil, RevClean Castor, T.S. Engine Oil or XERAMIC Castor Evolution 2T. Rotax engines mix 6 oz per gallon. Stock Honda mix 6 - 8 oz per gallon.

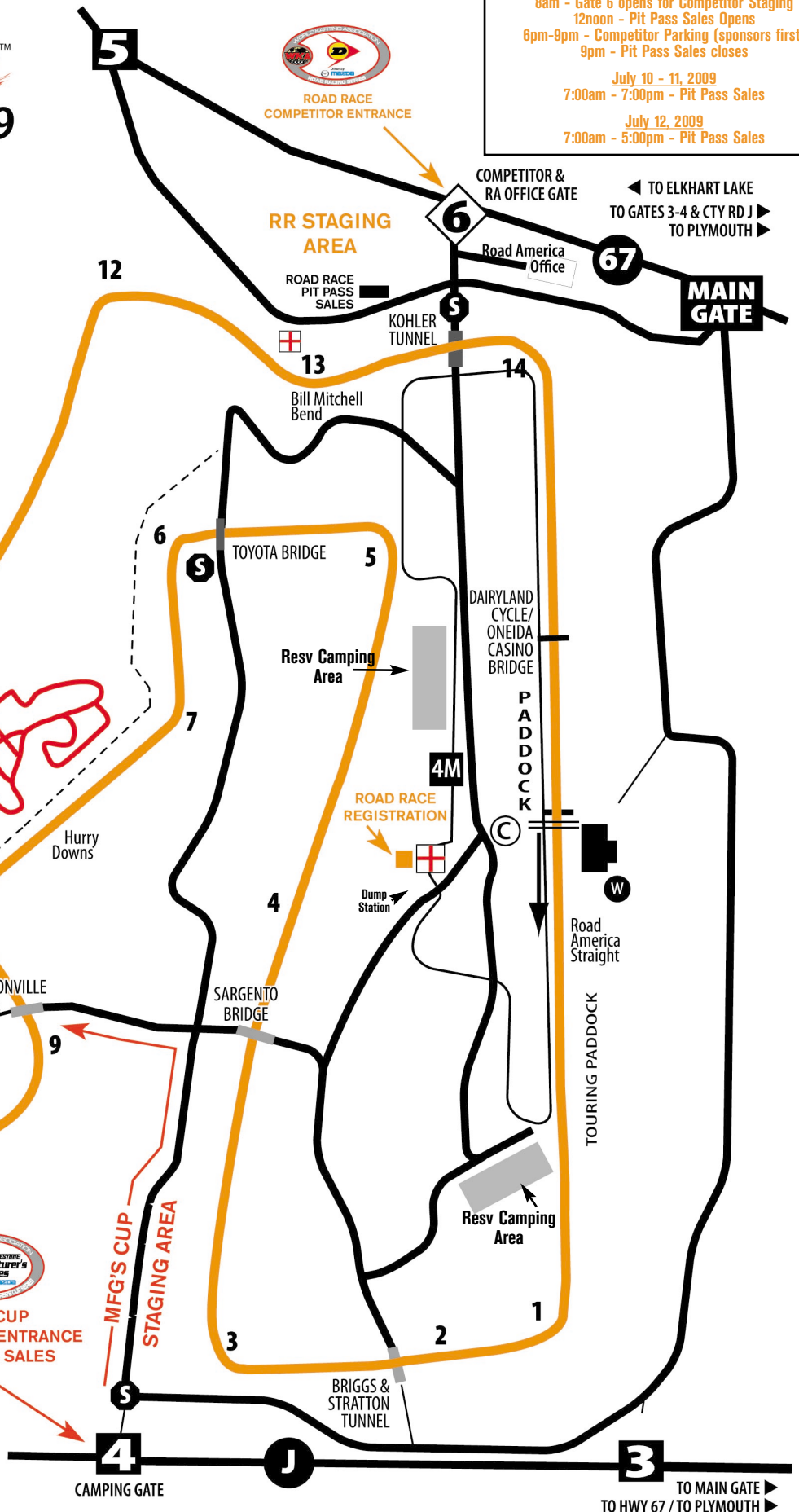

RULES OF ROAD AMERICA

1.0 ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE ROAD AMERICA RACE TRACK WILL HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.1 A current –VALID spectator ticket.
 - 1.1.1 A ticket with stub(s) upon entering.
 - 1.1.2 A ticket AND A VALID “Pass-Out” upon re-entering.
- 1.2 A VALID credential (accompanied by a signed insurance-waiver witnessed by Road America/Club Staff personnel (PARTICIPANTS ONLY):
 - 1.2.1 Road America CREDENTIAL.
 - 1.2.2 Event sponsoring CLUB CREDENTIAL, PROPERLY VALIDATED.
 - 1.2.3 Appropriate weekend WRIST BAND.

2.0 UNLICENSED VEHICLE GUIDELINES:

- 2.1 RACE VEHICLES being used in the race event are allowed on R/A property
- 2.2 AUTHORIZED ROAD AMERICA VEHICLES with a current year sticker are allowed on R/A property
- 2.3 Participants may use unlicensed light vehicles and equipment carts but must have a current event sticker or yearly permit for use of such vehicles on Road America property.
 - 2.3.1 “Pit vehicle” registration and fees must be taken care of at registration (alternate locations may apply)
 - 2.3.2 A liability waiver and acknowledgement of proper insurance coverage for all “pit vehicles” must be signed when registering the “pit vehicles”.
 - 2.3.3 Furthermore, according to the Wisconsin State Law , all ATVs should be registered by the State of Wisconsin, or by another State, in order to be operated within the State
- 2.4 ROLLERBLADES, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SKATE BOARDS, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SCOOTERS (THOSE KIND YOU STAND ON) AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property.
- 2.5 BICYCLES are permitted but may not be used in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA – this is strictly PROHIBITED.

3.0 ALL OPERATORS OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLES (including golf carts) ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST POSSESS A VALID STATE-ISSUED DRIVER’S LICENSE:

- 3.1 At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

4.0 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE COMPETITION PADDOCK UNTIL AFTER ALL RACE EVENTS HAVE CONCLUDED FOR THE DAY:

- 4.1 Spectators may only consume alcoholic beverages in the North Paddock, and other spectator areas.

5.0 RACE ENGINES MAY NOT BE RUN WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION:

- 5.1 Before 8:00 AM weekends/8:30 AM weekdays
- 5.2 After 6:00 PM weekends/5:00 PM weekdays
- 5.3 Car Clubs must vacate the property by 7:00 PM each day
- 5.4 On-Track Operations 8:00 – 6:00 Weekends, 8:30 – 5:00 Weekdays
- 5.5 When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 pm applies. Generators can be used but must not disturb other teams or campers.

6.0 ALL VEHICLES OR TENTS REMAINING OVERNIGHT ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST HAVE:

- 6.1 A valid Road America overnight camping permit PROPERLY DISPLAYED.
- 6.2 Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or motor home equipment.

7.0 NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION. PETS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY MUST EITHER BE:

- 7.1 Kept within the vehicle with adequate ventilation and fresh drinking water.
- 7.2 Kept under control of a leash.

8.0 FIRES, WHEN CONDITIONS PERMIT, MUST:

- 8.1 Be used for cooking only.
- 8.2 Be contained within a device designed for containing a fire.
- 8.3 Be completely extinguished before the coals, ashes, and remains are discarded.
- 8.4 Not be within 10 feet of spectator containment fence.
- 8.5 Not be within 100 feet of an occupied Road America concession stand.
- 8.6 Not be near other competitors’ gasoline storage areas.

9.0 AT NO TIME SHALL A VEHICLE BE PERMITTED TO TRAVEL COUNTER – CLOCKWISE ON TRACK!

10.0 DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:

- 10.1 Please do not drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces
- 10.2 Do not deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings
- 10.3 Do not tamper with electrical facilities or any other facilities on Road America property. There are fines for any destruction of property.
- 10.4 RA is not responsible for damage caused by other’s actions.
- 10.5 Check voltage in electrical receptacles before using

11.0 ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREWORKS, FIREARMS OR ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE ARE NOT ALLOWED ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY!

12.0 VENDING is not allowed on Road America property without obtaining the proper permit. To obtain such permit, a vendor fee must be paid. This fee varies per event. Contact Road America for details and prices and to make arrangements.
