EVENT INFORMATION

ENTRY FEES:

\$65 Pre-entry, \$70 at the track, Kid Karts \$15/day (Fees are per class and pit pass is not included with entry). \$40 Money Race. WKA National Event Temporary Memberships available - \$20 per driver, per event.

PIT PASSES:

Event Pass \$20, Children 5 & under \$8. DO NOT PURCHASE PIT PASSES IN ADVANCE.

PRACTICE:

Thursday August 20th, \$25 per driver. Fee is payable to NCMP at the track. Friday, August 21, \$25 w/ pre-entry, \$35 at track. You must be entered in a class to practice. Kid Karts are not required to pay for Friday practice.

PARKING:

\$40 per 12'x40' space. Anything longer than 40' is considered as 2 spots. Side-pitting is also considered as 2 spots. Free parking is available at the track. Requests to pit with someone will be considered, however, not guaranteed. Note: Additional pit spots cannot be purchased for the sole use of parking a tow vehicle. Contact Mike Adams 765.987.8090. Directions: NCMP is 45 minutes East of Downtown Indianapolis on I-70 and State Road 3. Take I-70 to Exit 123 (New Castle), turn South on SR3 and go South 1/4-mile South of the Flying J, turn left onto new gravel road and follow 1/4-mile to NCMP gate (Be careful when navigating via GPS).
