ENTRY FEES:

Briggs Charity Race \$50 per driver, all other classes: \$90 pre-entry, \$100 at track. Pit pass not included with entry. (Temporary Membership available at \$20 per driver for the weekend.)

PIT PASSES:

\$30 Event pass sold Thur & Fri, \$25 2-day Event Pass sold Sat. \$15 1-day passes available Fri - Sun. Children 7 & under: \$15 Event pass, \$10 daily pass.. Do not purchase pit passes in advance. RA Minor Waiver signed by parent or legal guardian is required for all drivers under age 18.

PRACTICE:

Friday, July 9, \$70 per driver with pre-entry, \$95 at track. You must be entered in a class to practice.

CAMPING:

Camping is allowed throughout the RA facility and is available via permit Thursday - Saturday nights. Camping is not allowed outside the track. Fees are as follows: \$50 motorhomes, \$35 tents, \$20 Electrical hookups tags. All may be purchased with your pre-entry to WKA or at the Mfr Cup and Road Race event registration offices during the posted events hours of operation. IN addition, electric tags are also available for purchase at the 4-Mile Merchant from 10am-2pm Friday - Sunday. Late arrivals on 7/8 & 7/9 may camp overnight however must report to either the Mfr Cup or Road Race registration offices Friday or Saturday morning to purchase permits. Tents are not allowed in the paved/reserved camping areas. Showers and on-site dump stations available. REFUNDS:

No refunds after Tuesday, July 6, 2010 at 5pm.

MISCELLANEOUS:

No engines can be run before 8:30am or after 5pm on Friday and before 8am or after 6pm on Saturday & Sunday. All pre-entered competitors must personally pick up their pre-entry packet at registration and must also have personally executed their waiver signature when purchasing their pit pass. Facility must be vacated by 8pm Sunday. Late departure from the premises is by prior arrangement only - however, is not allowed in the paddock area. Violators are subject to a \$1,000 fee for release of unit.

PIT VEHICLES:

No bikes, skateboards, golf carts, 3 or 4 wheelers or any other form of unauthorized vehicles allowed in the pits during hot track hours. Handicap vehicles allowed via permit by WKA. ALL unlicensed vehicles (golf carts, scooters, mopeds, small 4-wheelers, etc.) must obtain a Road America Pit Vehicle Permit. Any motorized pit vehicle licensed to be on the road does not need this pass. Please complete the Pit Vehicle Permit located on the following pages. Rental golf carts are available through RA; contact Lori Bramstedt at 800.365.7223.

VENDOR NOTICE:

Any non-sponsor vendors wishing to sell or display at a WKA national event must contact the WKA Office 30 days prior to the event for a WKA Vendor License @ 704.455.1606. WKA reserves the right to limit non-sponsor vendors.

Directions: Take I-43 North from Milwaukee to Hwy 57 junction at Saukville. Go North on Hwy 57 to County J. Turn left (West) on County J. Go 2 miles to Hwy 67 and turn right (North). Proceed to Gate 6 (Competitor Gate) approximately 1 mile on your left.

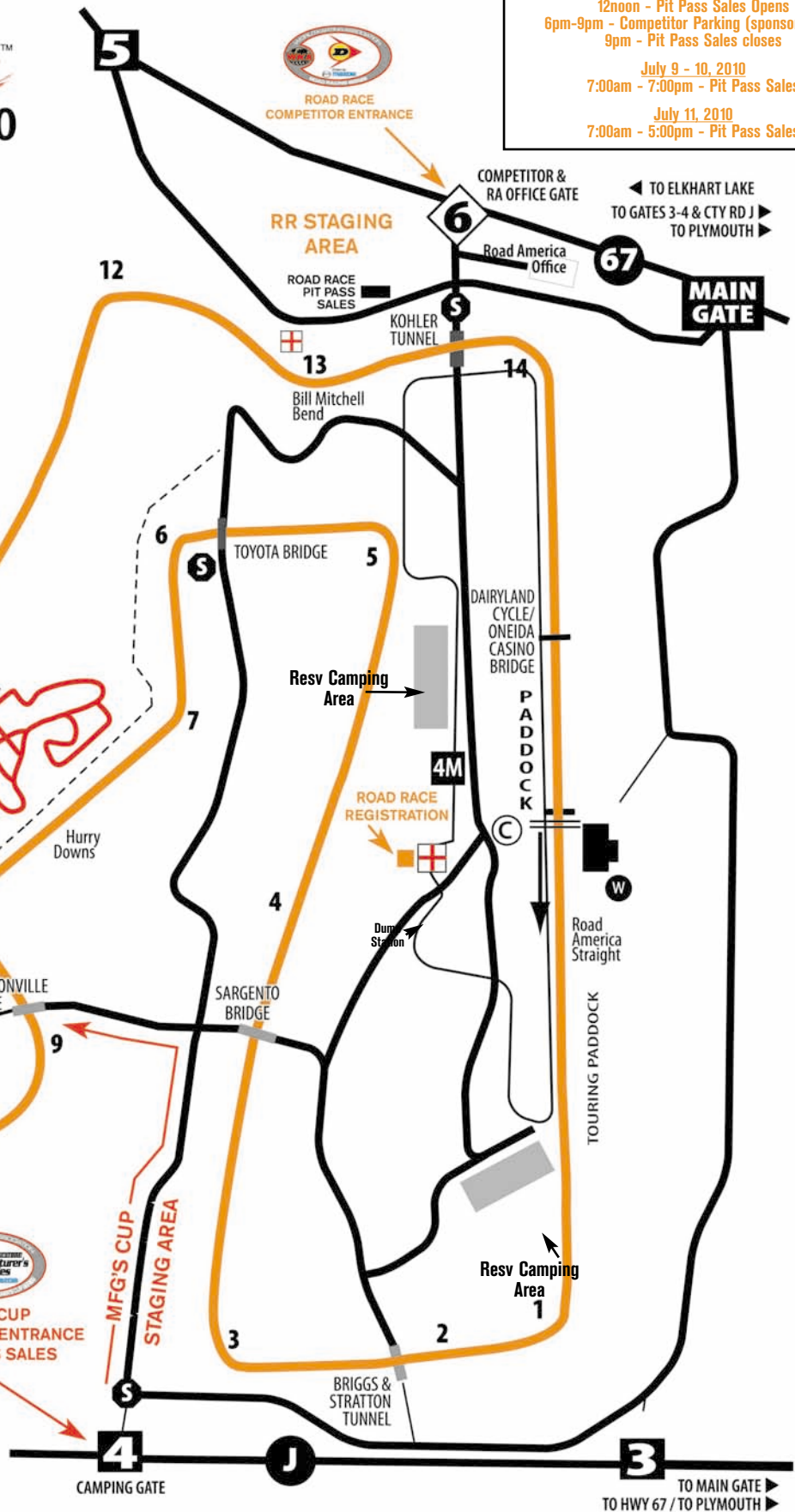

RULES OF ROAD AMERICA

1.0 ALL PERSONS ENTERING THE ROAD AMERICA RACE TRACK WILL HAVE ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:

- 1.1 A current –VALID spectator ticket.
 - 1.1.1 A ticket with stub(s) upon entering.
 - 1.1.2 A ticket AND A VALID “Pass-Out” upon re-entering.
- 1.2 A VALID credential (accompanied by a signed insurance-waiver witnessed by Road America/Club Staff personnel (PARTICIPANTS ONLY) :
 - 1.2.1 Road America CREDENTIAL.
 - 1.2.2 Event sponsoring CLUB CREDENTIAL which is PROPERLY VALIDATED.
 - 1.2.3 Appropriate weekend WRISTBAND.

2.0 UNLICENSED VEHICLE GUIDELINES:

- 2.1 RACE VEHICLES being used in the race event are allowed on R/A property
- 2.2 AUTHORIZED ROAD AMERICA VEHICLES with a current year sticker are allowed on R/A property
- 2.3 Participants may use unlicensed light vehicles and equipment carts but must have a current event sticker or yearly permit for use of such vehicles on Road America property. These will be referred to as “pit vehicles”.
 - 2.3.1 “Pit vehicle” registration and fees must be taken care of at registration (alternate locations may apply).
 - 2.3.2 A liability waiver and acknowledgement of proper insurance coverage for all “pit vehicles” must be signed when registering the “pit vehicles”.
 - 2.3.3 Furthermore, according to the Wisconsin State Law , all ATVs should be registered by the State of Wisconsin, or by another State, in order to be operated within the State
 - 2.3.4 Licensed scooters will require a “paddock access pass” if being used in the paddock on public race weekends. These passes can be obtained at registration by showing proof of current license plate status.
- 2.4 ROLLERBLADES, NON-MOTORIZED & MOTORIZED SKATE BOARDS, AND ROLLER SKATES are not permitted on Road America property.
- 2.5 BICYCLES are permitted but may not be ridden in the COMPETITION PADDOCK AREA – this is strictly PROHIBITED.

3.0 ALL OPERATORS OF ANY MOTOR VEHICLES (including golf cars) ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST POSSESS A VALID STATE-ISSUED DRIVER’S LICENSE:

- 3.1 At no time is anyone allowed to park in fire lanes. Violators will be towed.

4.0 CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED WITHIN THE COMPETITION PADDOCK UNTIL AFTER ALL RACE EVENTS HAVE CONCLUDED FOR THE DAY:

- 4.1 Spectators may only consume alcoholic beverages in the North Paddock, and other spectator areas.

5.0 RACE ENGINES MAY NOT BE RUN WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION:

- 5.1 Before 8:00 AM weekends/8:30 AM weekdays
- 5.2 After 6:00 PM weekends/5:00 PM weekdays
- 5.3 Car Clubs must vacate the property by 7:00 PM each day
- 5.4 On-Track Operations 8:00 – 6:00 Weekends, 8:30 – 5:00 Weekdays
- 5.5 When paddock space is in the Campground area, Campground quiet time of 10:00 pm applies. Generators can be used but must not disturb other teams or campers.

6.0 ALL VEHICLES OR TENTS REMAINING OVERNIGHT ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY MUST HAVE:

- 6.1 A valid Road America overnight camping permit PROPERLY DISPLAYED.
- 6.2 Overnight stays are not permitted without formal tent or motor home equipment.

7.0 NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY WITHOUT ROAD AMERICA PERMISSION. PETS ALLOWED ON THE PROPERTY MUST EITHER BE:

- 7.1 Kept within the vehicle with adequate ventilation and fresh drinking water.
- 7.2 Kept under control of a leash.

8.0 FIRES, WHEN CONDITIONS PERMIT, MUST:

- 8.1 Be used for cooking only.
- 8.2 Be contained within a device designed for containing a fire.
- 8.3 Be completely extinguished before the coals, ashes, and remains are discarded.
- 8.4 Not be within 10 feet of spectator containment fence.
- 8.5 Not be within 100 feet of an occupied Road America concession stand.
- 8.6 Not be near other competitors’ gasoline storage areas.

9.0 AT NO TIME SHALL A VEHICLE BE PERMITTED TO TRAVEL COUNTER – CLOCKWISE ON TRACK!

10.0 DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY:

- 10.1 Please do not drive stakes or poles into any asphalt surfaces
- 10.2 Do not deface, cut, drive nails into or attach lines or any other objects to trees, bushes, light poles, site sign posts or buildings
- 10.3 Do not tamper with electrical facilities or any other facilities on Road America property. There are fines for any destruction of property.
- 10.4 RA is not responsible for damage caused by other’s actions.
- 10.5 Check voltage in electrical receptacles before using

11.0 ILLEGAL DRUGS, FIREWORKS, FIREARMS OR ANY TYPE OF EXPLOSIVE ARE NOT ALLOWED ON ROAD AMERICA PROPERTY!

- 12.0 VENDING is not allowed on Road America property without obtaining the proper permit. To obtain such permit, a vendor fee must be paid. This fee varies per event. Contact Road America for details and prices and to make arrangements.

**2010 Road America
Pit Vehicle Registration and Agreement**

As part of our insurance requirements for 2010, Road America requires that all pit and other unlicensed or off-road vehicles used for Race Support maintain a valid Road America sticker displayed on the vehicle and a registration agreement on file with the Road America office and security. Licensed scooters will require a "paddock access pass" on public race weekends to be used in the paddock. These passes can be obtained from registration by showing proof of current year registration on the licensed vehicle.

In consideration for being permitted to utilize and operate a motorized pit vehicle on the Road America premises at any 2010 season event or activity, the vehicle owner and/or competition entrant:

1. Acknowledges and agrees that the vehicle shall be operated in compliance with the vehicle manufacturer's operating instructions and/or industry standards including those regarding riding/driving position and number of passengers.
2. Hereby assumes full responsibility for and assumes the risk of bodily injury, death, or property damage arising out of or related to the use of said vehicles whether caused by the negligence of owner and/or their operators, Road America, other pit vehicle operators or otherwise.
3. Acknowledges and agrees that all operators of said vehicles shall be at least 16 years old, have a valid state required driving license, and carry a minimum of one million dollars general liability insurance applicable to the operation of their pit vehicles and that all operators shall provide such license, proof of insurance, and other applicable credentials upon request of Road America or an event official.
4. Hereby acknowledges that the use of motorized pit vehicles is dangerous and involves the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage.
5. Agrees that the pit vehicle will be operated in a responsible manner and according to all additional Road America regulations and instructions, including but not limited to posted speed limits, designated roads and hours of and allowed locations for operations.
6. Acknowledges and agrees that pit vehicles are not allowed on the competition track surface, motorplex surface or hot pit lane at any time.
7. Acknowledges and agrees that pit vehicle operation/usage is for competitors and vendors only. Spectators are not allowed to operate pit vehicles at any time for any reason.
8.
