Age Supplement Reminders and Immediate Clarifications

WKA Junior Age Clarification

All drivers 15 and under must have a copy of their Birth Certificate if WKA needs to verify the driver's age.

Age eligible Drivers can **NOT** compete in Future Stars nor Jr 1.

Age eligible Drivers **CAN** compete in both
Junior 1/Junior 2 or Junior 2/Junior 3.

Junior 1 Drivers who are age 10 (Must be 10) may compete in
Junior 2 as well!

Junior 2 Drivers who are 12 (Must be 12) may complete in Junior 3
as well!

WKA National Dirt Series WKA Semi Pro Classes starting 10/1/22

Junior 3 Drivers that are 15 who want to run Junior 3 can compete
in both
Junior 3 and Semi Pro Divisions only.

Semi Pro drivers are eligible to compete in the Pro Classes any
Semi Pro Driver that wins any of the Pro classes (not warmup) in
the WKA National Dirt Series will lose their ability to compete in
Semi Pro Division in the WKA National Dirt Series for the balance
of the year.

Semi Pro drivers that Finish in the Top 2 in the Overall National Points or wins the Maxxis Nationals will not be able to run the Semi Pro class the following season at the WKA National Dirt Series or WKA Winter Dirt Series.

General

Drivers must adhere to the age supplement, starting with Daytona 2022.

Any WKA Sanctioned or Insured tracks that wishes to offer a deviation from these above age rules must contact WKA in advance to get approval.

It is the responsibility of the driver to make sure this is done in advance. Any driver in violation will face possible penalties that will limit the driver's ability to compete in the WKA National Dirt Series or the WKA Winter Dirt Series.

The WKA Insurance Program has age rules in place to protect all drivers in each class, as well as the promoters and insured tracks.
