Junior All Pro 8-11 290lbs Green Plate
Junior All Pro 12-15 320lbs Blue Plate (Big Pipe for Winter Series)
Amateur 14-up 350lbs
Hobby 14-up 375/425lbs
No Pro & Semi Pro 14-up 375lbs
Clone Medium 15-up 350lbs
Champ Senior 15-up 425lbs
Flat Head Limited 15-up 390lbs (Except when noted 375lbs)
All Clone Heavy 15-up 375lbs (Except when noted 390lbs)
All Super Heavy 15-up 425lbs (Driver weight 200lbs)
All Pro 15-up 375lbs (Except when noted 390lbs)

All drivers 15 and under must have a copy of their Birth Certificate if WKA needs to verify the driver's age.

Driver's age is determined by the driver's age starting with Daytona Kart Week, if a driver is currently 9 but will be 10 in the upcoming competition year, the driver's age is 10.

Age eligible Drivers can **NOT** compete in Future Stars and Junior 1

Age eligible Drivers **CAN** compete in both.

Junior 1/Junior 2 or Junior 2/Junior 3.

Junior 3 Drivers that are age eligible 14 **CAN** compete in Junior 3, Amateur, Hobby & No Pro

If you have won a championship as Senior in any major event/series in the last 3 years, Examples: Maxxis Nationals, GOAT Series, WKA Dirt Series, you cannot run in Semi Pro/No Pro Amateur or Hobby.

Drivers that are obtained age 14 and want to run Pro classes as a 15-year-old can apply for a Waiver if the following criteria is met, the Driver must have won a WKA National Championship in the prior year and must provide 3 Industry references and acknowledge they no longer have Junior Class eligibility. Waivers are still subject to final approval of the WKA National Dirt Series.
